

Pringle Richards Sharratt designed the temporary ticket pavilion for the Summer Opening of the Houses of Parliament. The pavilion is situated on Abingdon Green, opposite the Palace of Westminster, in the setting of a Grade 1 listed building, on a World Heritage Site.

The pavilion was designed to be used every year between July and September for the sale of tickets for timed tours of Parliament. The practice was commissioned in March 2003 and the pavilion was in use by July 2003.

The pavilion is a laminated timber structure with a membrane roof and was designed to be dismantled at the end of the season, and then stored for re-erection the following year.
